The NeuroMed Electroanalgesic Delivery System with the *MATRIX PMT System software version 2/2.0* can successfully treat a multitude of medical conditions, resulting in the most advanced state-of-the- art pain management system. Frequency ranges from .01-250 pps, (with the ability to effect the nerves by stimulating or facilitating), but also using a High Definition frequency generator (HDfg)*TM* that can produce much higher frequencies (or pulses per second) from *5,000 pps*, to as high as *8,300 pps* to inhibit (interrupt) the pain signals.
